***Alpacas must be registered in the name of the owner as listed on the ARI Certificate or the exhibitor must provide a Owner of Record form, signed by the owner that is listed on the certificate.

Venue Rules

~No Dogs and No Smoking allowed in show/stalling area, the Carriage room or Legacy room.

Classes

~See the Class Information List. One Entry Fee per Halter Class & One Premium Fee per Halter class is required.

~Production classes require one entry Fee per Production class & one Premium Fee per production class.

~Performance classes only require a minimal entry fee & NO Premium Fee, Except the Gambler's Choice and Egg Race (these classes are free).

Entry Fees

~All Halter & Performance Class Entry fees include the \$6 AOBA Show Division Fee.

~Premium fees are separate - see below.

Premium Fees

~All Premium fees for Halter Classes are per alpaca in addition to the entry fee

~All premium fees for Production Classes are per class in addition to the production class entry fee.

~No Premium fees for Performance Classes will be collected or paid.

Production Classes: We will Present the Production Classes at the beginning of the show.

~The Production Class Fees are charged per class entered for all production classes (including Best of Three, Get of Sire, Produce of Dam, and Bred and Owned).

~ If we have the numbers to host a Best in Show class, this class will not be required to pay a premium fee and no premium will be paid for this class)

~All Production Class Entry Fees include the \$6 AOBA fee.

~If you wish to sign up for a Production Class on arrival to the show, Please notify the Show Superintendent of your intent to enter a production class ASAP upon check in. The classes will be held at 10:00 A.M. promptly on Saturday morning, limiting late class entry.

~If possible, please coordinate with known owners of herdsire or dam progeny prior to show to expedite entry.

Performance Classes: We will Present the Performance Classes on Sunday in the Suri ring.

~There are no Premium Fee charges for Performance Classes.

~The Performance Fees are per Class entered, except Gambler's Choice and the Egg Race which require no fee

~We will try to give a small cash prize to Performance Class winners (unrelated to the premium payout program)-details at show.

Refunds:

~No refund of entry will be allowed unless a veterinarian's certificate of illness, injury, or death is presented to the Show Superintendent by 8:00 P.M. on Friday, October 20, 2010. No refunds/cancellations of stall space after October 20, 2010.
